Meeting called to order at 0900. Commissioner Lee called the meeting to order.

- OT Discussion
 - Chief Bucy presented an overview of expected savings for 2021. Commissioner Lee also stated he did a spot audit and noticed a reduction already.
 - Commissioners requested that the wildland (mobe) dollar amount be added to the OT report (below wildland hours).
 - Commissioners requested the OT report be included in their packets
 - Need the dollar amount for the COVID 2020 OT expense
- Discussion on planning for upcoming Levy LID lift voting
 - Chief Bucy provided a 5-year history of what the levies have cost the average homeowner and what 2022 might look like.
 - Chief Bucy will try and get the average home assessed value for FD 1.
 - Discussion on insurance savings due to our new WSRB ratings
- Big ticket items
 - Chief Bucy presented a "top 4" major operational expenses that the district will be incurring in the 1-5-year range.
 - Radios
 - Pagers
 - SCBAs
 - Fire Engines
- Reserve Borrowing
 - Due to 2020 tight budget constraints, we need to borrow from our reserve accounts.
 - Commissioner Wells voted to allow up to \$300,000 combined from the EMS & Fire reserves to be utilized to

meet budgetary needs through the May tax draw, to be paid back at the first opportunity. Commissioner Whittaker second the motion, all in favor.

• Commissioner Lee discussed the strategic planning tools and who to let have access. It was agreed that the full tim and office staff have access to the planning tools.
