CHIEF'S REPORT

See attached report.

- 1. MVA update; FF Schade, had 1 plate and 10 screws for his wrist surgery. Lt. Vandervert has been medically cleared to return by the end of this week. Both will be continuing their care as directed by their physicians. I am still working with the adjuster in regards to finalizing numbers for the Engine claim.
- 2. Fires; numerous in the last two weeks; ATV's, Equipment hitting a rock, suspicious origin, unknown causes, and some still under investigation. The response by the crews has been phenomenal, our training and efforts have really shined over these last few very busy weeks. Our mutual aid responses have been amazing as well. On the 41 acre fire at Stonelodge on July 3rd we had; 200 personnel and 13 aircraft, no homes were lost. We have also provided mutual aid to our neighboring districts during these very busy times.
- 3. Grants; County Commissioner Wes McCart has asked me to be apart of the meetings to distribute the \$4.2 million that has been allocated to the County thru the American Recovery Act. I will attend the first meeting next week.
- 4. Calls; Our call volume is running considerably higher, we are already 227 calls over last year at this same time. We had 20 calls on the 4th of July alone, not too many were fireworks related. We are averaging 5+ runs per day, with over 50 this month already.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

The strategy meeting that was scheduled for the 8th will need to be rescheduled at our next regular Commissioners meeting on the 19th. The newspaper has been notified.

b. WASHINGTON STATE AUDITOR ANNUAL REPORT REVIEW

Commissioner Wells met with Office Administrator Cari Richardson at the District Office on June 22nd to review the report. His findings were as follows: They found no additional items to add, all grants were reported, and no issues were found. Our Office Administrator did a wonderful job. The relationship between the Treasurer's office and ours is staler; the Auditor's office relationship is improving. Our staff is liked and communication is good. Excellent review process for the C4 report.
