A type 2 team has been requested, I will meet with them on Tuesday. Our strike team is in Williams Valley. There are currently 3 State mobilizations, resources are low.
- 2. Summit fire; crested the ridge last night.
- 3. Molybdenite and Nine Mine should be de-mobilizing on Thursday

#### Administrative –

- 1. We will be reimbursed for the pagers with the 50/50 grant
- 2. The Levy appears to be passing with a 59% approval
